purpose of an advisory board?

The GPLT technical committee is a volunteer group formed to give advice and support to board of directors and executive. They contribute to the organization in many different ways

- 1- Established to involve prospective donors, offering them a forum to give advice as well as donate and fund raise.
- 2- Representative of the community, such as young adults to provide input on the organization's work.

It is important for technical committee members and the board of directors to understand their roles and the differences between the two groups. Failing to do so may cause confusion.

Unlike the board of directors, an technical committee does not have formal legal responsibilities or decision-making authority and cannot issue directives that must be followed. technical committee typically do not have as many rules and procedures, such as those concerning board elections, as a board of directors.

Instead, like other committees, a technical committee makes recommendations and provides information and materials to the board of directors. The technical committee's tasks and powers are delegated by and subject to the direction and control of the board of directors.
